



Acceptable entry qualifications

This qualifications list is for individuals looking to attend our range of Electrician Plus aligned and periodic inspection and test qualifications (2391-51/52). This ensures you have the right qualifications required to satisfy the entry requirements. The qualifications below are taken from the August 2023 EAS Qualifications Guide.

Qualifications referenced in the Tables below may be evidenced by providing valid ECS card information (either ECS card number, image) and ECS CPD record, which can be freely verified using the ECS Check systems or CSCS Smart Check App. An ECS Registered Electrician Gold Card with the occupation of Installation Electrician, which will show the relevant version of BS 7671, should typically be sufficient to demonstrate compliance with the qualification requirements in the Table below.

An ECS Card with occupation of Maintenance Electrician may be suitable if the underpinning qualifications align with requirements of the Tables below.

Where an ECS card is or has been held, ECS can verify if an individual's qualifications are sufficient when qualification certificates are inaccessible or unavailable.

Candidates must hold one of these Craft Qualifications and the achievement measurement competency assessment/end point assessment certificate is also required where relevant.

NOTE - LCL Awards is a trading name of Logic Certification, qualifications may have been previously issued in this name.

- 2. Certificates of unit credit are not sufficient evidence of meeting the prerequisite qualification requirements in lieu of full certificates.
- 3. Evidence confirming registration with a competent person's scheme and/or Qualified Supervisor status does not meet the entry requirements in lieu of full certificates.
